The purpose of this form is to provide a format for communicating important information about your child to the child's teachers. This will enhance the teachers' understanding of your child and facilitate setting mutual parent-teacher goals and expectations in a collaborative process.

Report Format

We invite you to share in writing your thoughts about your child's disposition, activities, interests, work, and social interactions in and out of school. The **questions below are provided to** *stimulate your thinking*. You may respond to specific questions or write more spontaneously according to what you feel is important.

OR you may use the questions as a reference for verbally describing your child at the fall conference.

Summing Up How would you characterize your child's strengths and vulnerabilities?
