As you know, we are living in a digital age. Most new families that inquire about SRV have found us or looked us up on the web. Many of you look to the web, email and social media to keep up with school and other news. For the school, sharing information electronically is usually the most expedient, "greenest," and most efficient way of reaching you.

We have an official SRV website for the school that includes information for prospective parents, other teachers interested in progressive education, SRV alumnae and our own parent community. The site is a vital marketing tool. The address is www.theschoolinrosevalley.org.

Within the official school website is a password-protected Parent Portal. On these pages parents will find important information and communications from the school, such as forms, school cancellations, the calendar of events and classroom activities.

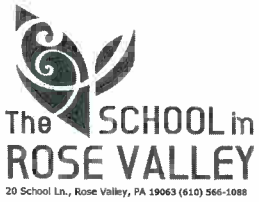
From year to year, some SRV classrooms also have individual classroom password-protected web pages or blogs for students and parents. Here teachers might share the week's news, post suggestions for extended learning activities for students and parents, and students' work. We realize some parents are concerned about the school using photographs of their children on the web. We, too, want to do everything we can to ensure their safety. For their protection, we have adopted the guidelines below.

Please read the guidelines carefully. Unless we hear otherwise, we will assume that we have your permission to post your child's photograph on the school's official web site, both the public and private pages, the school's Facebook page, and the school's YouTube account. **If you wish to withdraw your permission for your child's picture to appear on any of these sites, you must fill out the form below and return it to the school office.**

Guidelines for The School in Rose Valley's Web Site

- Recognizable images of individual children's faces may be posted on the school's official web site public and password-protected pages, on the school's Facebook page and on the school's YouTube account, unless their parents/guardians withdraw their specific consent for this on the form below.
- No student's last name will be posted by the school anywhere on the web.
- If there is ever a photograph of one child alone, the child's first name will not be used in direct relation to that photograph. (That is, there will never be a photograph of a child on its own web page, or a photograph of one child and that child's name under the photograph. There may be a picture of one child and many quotes from other children on the page, including a quote by that child, not near the picture.)
- No students' images will be posted by the school to a site other than one hosted by SRV without the parents'/guardians' specific consent. In such a case, the students' last names will not be used, and their first names will never be directly related to their images.
- All email addresses on the website will belong to a staff member, never a student.
- Student biographical information will NEVER be given out on the web site by the students or the staff.
