community support has always been a hallmark of SRV, and this has never rung more true. When the School first faced the COVID pandemic, there were many unknowns. It was unclear how long the crisis would last, how we would be impacted financially, or if students and staff could endure the necessary changes and sacrifices.

We still have much work to do and are still facing the challenges of COVID, but we will survive. Enrollment is currently 155 students — a 30% increase — and almost all of our fantastic staff are returning this fall. These are good signs.

Because we were uncertain about how giving would be impacted last year, we kept our fundraising goals in line with previous years, despite a significant financial need created by the pandemic. Donors came through big time. Annual giving surpassed our target by 59%. A large part of this came through new enrollment in the Pennsylvania Individual

EITC program. EITC funds directly support tuition assistance, help SRV enroll a more diverse student body, and accept families who want to choose SRV regardless of their financial situation. Please read about this program on the back cover of this report and consider participating if you're eligible.

Despite this outpouring of support, we are facing a rebuilding year. Meeting the early demands of the pandemic meant accessing our capital reserves, and we will need to restore those. And with more students come greater costs. Continuing to provide competitive compensation and benefits and support our teachers fully will result in continued retention, excellent care, and high-quality teaching, all of which lead to incredible outcomes for our students. Your ongoing support will help us maintain a healthy and robust school and realize a sustainable future for SRV.

SRV is pleased to introduce The Orchard Society. Your investment of \$350 can turn into \$3,500 for SRV through the PA Individual EITC program!



This year, SRV received almost \$90,000 in individual EITC contributions. These funds are restricted for tuition assistance and directly support our goals of enrolling and retaining a more racially and economically diverse student body. This program allows donors to receive a credit (refund) on their PA taxes equivalent to 90%

of their EITC gift. The minimum contribution through this program is \$3,500. If your household pays at least \$3,500 in PA taxes (approximately \$115,000 in taxable income,) you can take advantage of this program. Your contribution of \$3,500 to SRV will result in a tax credit/refund of \$3,150, costing you only \$350 after your taxes are filed. Your gift of \$10,000 will earn you \$9,000 back on your taxes.
